

Santa Barbara Unified School District Board Policy

BP 5112.5

Students

OPEN/CLOSED CAMPUS

In order to give students an opportunity to demonstrate responsibility and positive citizenship, the Governing Board establishes an open campus in which students shall have the privilege of leaving campus during lunch according to the following regulations:

Dos Pueblos: Junior and seniors only with parent permission
San Marcos: Junior and seniors only with parent permission
Santa Barbara: All grades

The privilege of open campus may be revoked from individual students for disciplinary reasons.

(cf. 5144 - Discipline)

Students shall not leave the school grounds at any other time during the school day without written permission of their parents/guardians and school authorities. Students who leave school or who fail to return following lunch without authorization shall be classified truant and subject to disciplinary action.
